## OVERSEAS LAY MISSION PROGRAM



### About Franciscan Mission Service:

Franciscan Mission Service (FMS) is a nonprofit organization that provides Catholic laity the opportunity to serve in solidarity with economically marginalized communities around the world. FMS trains, sends, and supports volunteers to serve others in a way that is respectful of cultural, religious, and personal differences. Since 1990, FMS has supported lay missionaries in 20 different countries and currently supports missionaries in Bolivia, Guatemala and Jamaica.

### About the Overseas Lay Mission Program:

The Overseas Lay Mission Program offers Catholic adults opportunities to serve alongside people living on the margins while growing in Franciscan values of peace, justice, reconciliation, and care for creation. In the spirit of Saints Francis and Clare, our Catholic lay missionaries serve for 2 or more years in a variety of ministries in solidarity with economically poor and oppressed communities in Latin America and the Caribbean. Our possible mission sites this year include Bolivia, Guatemala, and Jamaica. This transformative experience is enriched by an intentional Christian community, in which missionaries focus on simple living, prayer, reflection, and living the Gospel mission of “service and action for a more just and humane world.”

### Key Program Benefits:

- Immersion in a new culture and host community, where you will serve and learn alongside community members and local Franciscans
- Training in a 3-month Formation program, funding for two retreats or self-care while on mission, and a 3-week Re-Entry Retreat upon return to the U.S.
- Spiritual direction and ample opportunities to deepen one’s faith
- A fully-furnished bedroom, monthly stipend, and health insurance

### Responsibilities

- Partnering with ministry sites affiliated with Franciscan orders that in fields such as education, prison ministry, youth outreach, community health, elderly care, special needs children, pastoral ministry, sustainable agriculture, etc.
- An interest in serving in solidarity with the economically poor
- Humility and openness to learning from the host culture and community
- A Franciscan disposition towards relationship-building that views each person as an individual who is created and loved by God

### Required Qualifications:

- A lay Catholic open to the Franciscan tradition who can commit to at least two years of service.
- Single, married, or divorced — generally between the ages of 22 and 62 (without dependents).
- Prior cross-cultural experience and/or a second language are valuable, though not required.
